

## **WORKSHOPS FOR 2012**

Workshops will be held on Saturday mornings in February, March and April as listed below starting at 9 am and finishing by 11.30 am. Cost is \$5 per person per session.

Any session attracting fewer than four players a week before its scheduled date will be cancelled.

### **FEBRUARY 4<sup>th</sup>, 11<sup>th</sup> and 18<sup>th</sup>                      Defence**

These three workshops are designed to give players who are interested in improving their defensive play some tips on how to do so. The first is on defence in general and opening leads, the second is on signalling and the third is on more advanced signals. I strongly advise you to bring a regular partner to these sessions.

### **March 10<sup>th</sup>                      End Plays & Gerber with Extended CRO Responses**

Find out how to end play your opponents. The CRO system allows the suits of certain pairs of Aces (and possibly Kings) to be identified when bidding to Slam.

### **March 17<sup>th</sup>                      Splinter Bids & Roman Key Card Blackwood (RKCB)**

Splinter bids are used to show good support for the last bid suit and a singleton in another suit. It is a game force bid showing slam possibilities. RKCB assists in slam bidding.

### **March 31<sup>st</sup>                      Transfers over 1NT Opening**

The advantages of playing this system is that when you play in a suit after a 1NT opening, the lead is into the stronger hand and responder can show a wide variety of hands.

### **April 14<sup>th</sup>                      Hamilton/Capelletti overcalls after 1NT**

This system gives you a defence to 1NT bids by the opposition.
